

In 1982, Father Paolo Dall'Oglio, founder of Al-Khalil community, came accross the ruins of the ancient Syriac monastery of Saint-Moses the Abyssinian (Deir Mar Moussa) dating back to the 6th Century.

He settled there for a ten-day spiritual retreat and thought of three ways to breathe new life into this place : prayer, hand labor and hospitality.

To him, the Islamo-Christian reconciliation was a necessity
"Syria admirably synthesises modern citizenship with a strong cultural identity,
heir to the classic Arab-Muslim civilisation where the disciples of Mohammed,
Jesus and Moses built one rich human civilisation."

Deir Maryam Al-Adhra (Virgin Mary Monastery) in Sulaymaniya,
Iraqi Kurdistan Region, was born from that spirit.

For thematic exhibitions, theatre performances, concerts,...


The Library,

DEIR MARYAM AL-ADHRA, A HEART THAT BEATS IN NORTHEASTERN IRAQ, KURDISTAN REGION




A heart that beats to the rhythms of singing classes of singing courses, musical notes, drawing workshops or general education.



On the property of Deir Maryam Al-Adhra, additional rooms have been built for courses intended to the youth, adult meetings, and entertainment for everyone.

These rooms also serve as venues for the English, Kurdish and Arabic as well as various cultural activities, as well as a daycare and a kindergarten.

"Our aim is to create a spiritual center, a library of inter-religious research and a hall with 200 seats for inter-cultural meetings." The Islamo-Christian dialogue through peaceful coexistence and spiritual and intellectual sharing is the mission of Deir Maryam al-Adhra.








The buildings around the church of Deir Maryam Al-Adhra are dedicated for reception and administration. A building accommodates our nuns

A DEDICATED SPACE FOR HOUSING AND COURSES





This space, located near Deir Maryam Al-Adhra, was first an emergency home for the families who fled from ISIS. Today, some of these families are still present in a part of these housings, while the other part has been assigned to courses.

SOME FIGURES

- 10 container-houses including 5 occupied by the displaced families, and the rest are available as emergency homes or for guests.
- 19 rooms for the community, the volunteers and guests. (With a hosting capacity of 19-65 persons).
- 6 course halls in the buildings.
- 10 course halls in the container-houses.
- 1 reading hall.
- 3 smaller multi-purpose halls.

Operation Costs:

- Support of hosted displaced families :4 000 €/year.
- Water, electricity systems (30%) and Electricity generator (60%) for the 5 buildings:
 17 000 €/year.
- Salaries for maintenance : 15 000 €/year.
- Maintenance, materials and repairs :
 13 000 €/year.
- Hospitality / food : 11 000 €/year.

DEIR MARYAM AL-ADHRA









Since the beginning, we noticed at Deir Maryam Al-Adhra the communication problem between the various ethnicities of the local population, especially Arabs and Kurds. And thus we discussed as a community the possibility of creating a language school. In 2015, following the arrival of displaced Christians, we organized courses of Kurdish language to help them integrate. At the end of 2016, the courses were open to all the Arab-speaking displaced people. In 2017, at the initiative of an NGO, we organized English language courses. At the same time, we followed the wish of young Kurds in Sulaimaniyah who were interested in taking arabic language classes. Today, the concept of Dangakan isn't limited to a language school, but is becoming a community college that, through its courses, makes available the fundamental vocabulary for philosophical reflections, inter-religious dialogue, psychology, human rights, science...

Deir Maryam Al-Adhra and the Yazidis of Kanakawa







Kanakawa is a small Kurdish village 20 Kilometres away from the monastery, it has hosted the displaced Yazidis from Sinjar after the attack of ISIS.

Since the winter of 2015, humanitarian relationships were developed between our community and the inhabitants of Kanakawa. Among other activities, we organised courses in collaboration with small NGOs, these courses enabled children, adolescents, and adults to follow general cultural education. Since the beginning of 2018, we have been running a small centre of cultural activities founded by a local NGO.

SOME FIGURES

- 37 Yazidi Families with a total of approximately 200 people.
- 1000 families from the local Kurdish community with a total exceeding 4000 people.
- 154 course participants in 2018. Costs :
- courses : 7 200 €/year.
- Day care and tutoring: 2000 €/year.
- Maintenance: 7 000 €/year.
- Water and electricity: 1800 €/year.



Professional Training Has its own future!



The monastery has suitable locations for training for professions like electricity, plumbing, ironworks, welding, carpentry, sewing, administration office,...

The professional formation is part of the range of activities of Deir Maryam al-Adhra.

The accommodation structure and the qualified staff will be available once the financial means allow it.

SOME FIGURES

6 to 9 13-week Trainings: 250 hours each (on average) for classes of 12 to 18 people: from 6 000 € to 10 000 € depending on the training.

Course estimate : 63 000 €/year.




