



How to get to Pax-Bank

By aeroplane

From the airport Fiumicino (Leonardo da Vinci) you can take the shuttle bus to Rome centre.

Alternatively you can take the express train "Leonardo Express Aeroporto-Roma Termini" from the airport to the main railway station "Roma-Termini" which leaves every 30 minutes (to continue from Termini pls. see "By train").

But you can also take the regional train "Fiumicino Aeroporto-Orte" to the station "Stazione San Pietro" (attention: in this case you must change the train at the station "Stazione Trastevere") or you can take a Taxi from there.

By train

You can get to the main railway station of Rome "Roma Termini" by numerous national and international connections. From the main station (main exit) you can take the bus number 64 to the stop "Via di Porta Cavalleggeri". Then, our bank is just a couple of steps away.

Alternatively, starting at the main railway station "Termini" you can also also take the local train (treno regionale) "Roma-Civitaveccia" to the station "Stazione San Pietro" which is close by our bank.

By car

Please follow the traffic signs "Città del Vaticano" o "San Pietro" (in case you are arriving in Rome via motorway-circle "Grande Raccordo Annulare" (G.R.A.), you should leave at "SS1 Aurelia"). The Pax-Bank is close by the Vatican area. A parking place (fee-based) can be found opposite of Pax-Bank (diagonally) under the railway bridge which leads to the Vatican.

By public transport

subway (metro): The closest metro station is "Ottaviano/San Pietro" (line A) just north of S. Peter's Square. From there you can reach our bank (by foot) in about 10-15 minutes.

bus: The bus stop "Via di Porta Cavalleggeri, is very close to our bank, you can get there:

- from Piazza Venezia with line 64
- furthermore from Piazza Venezia (in front of the church "San Marco" in Via di San Marco) with the lines 46 and 916
- from Via Paola at the end of Corso Vittorio
 Emanuelle II (Lungotevere) with the lines 881, 98
 and 46
- from Piazza dei Cinquecento (at Termini main exit) with line 64.
